1920	-	<u>Reduced</u> to a Cadre
1935	-	<u>Disbanded</u> and absorbed into 6 Coy

- Sep 1939 - Formed as a Fd Pk Coy
- Oct 1939 - FRANCE with 4 Div
- Jun 1940 - UK
- Mar 1943 - N. AFRICA
- Dec 1943 - EGYPT
- Feb 1944 - ITALY
- Dec 1944 - GREECE
- 1945 - Left Greece
- Apr 1947 - Disbanded
- May 1950 - Formed as an Engr Pk Sqn in 35 Army Engr Regt in EGYPT
- Nov 1950 - Redesignated a Corps Fd Pk Sqn
- 1953 - Redesignated a Fd Pk Sqn
- 1954 - Becomes an Indep Unit but under comd 35 Regt
- Jan 1954 - To CYPRUS with 35 Regt
- Nov 1955 - Transfers to 37 Fd Engr Regt, still in Cyprus
- Nov 1959 - Disbanded in Cyprus
- Feb 1960 - 'A' Sqn of 12 (SME) Regt is re-titled 18 SME Sqn at CHATHAM
- Jul 1962 - SME granted title Royal and Sqn become 18 RSME Sqn
- Nov 1965 - Amalgamates with 40 RSME Sqn to form 18/40 RSMNE Sqn
- Aug 1966 - Move to CHATTENDEN with the Regt
- Nov 1969 - Re-formed as 18 RSME Sqn

- Dec 1982 - Redesignated 18 RSME Sp Sqn on amalgamation with
40 Sp Sqn
