Oct 1902	-	CHATHAM
Apr 1907	-	Redesignated a <u>Fortress 1 of C Coy</u>
1910	-	Redesignated a <u>Works L of C Coy</u>
Aug 1917	-	FRANCE
1916	-	Redesignated an <u>Adv Pk Coy</u>
Nov 1918	-	Redesignated a <u>GHQ Tps Coy</u>
Jul 1919	-	<u>Reduced</u> to a Cadre and to UK
Jan 1920	-	Reformed as an <u>Army Tps Coy</u>
1920	-	CONSTANTINOPLE were absorbed 137 Army Troop Coy
Nov 1922	-	GALLIPOLI
Sep 1923	-	<u>Disbanded</u> in Constantinople
(Note – no connection with wartime 29 Rly Svy Coy 1943 – 1946)		
Nov 1947	-	Formed as a <u>Fd Sqn</u> in BAOR by re-titling 629 Fd Sqn
Dec 1947	-	<u>Disbanded</u>
1948	-	Formed as a <u>Fd Sqn</u> in BAOR

Apr 1950 - Redesignated an Indep Fd Sqn

Mar 1950 - BERLIN

Dec 1950 - To Hamelin to join 26 Fd Engr Regt as a Fd Sqn

  

Nov 1957 - When Regt disbanded, came under comd HQRE 4 Div

Nov 1961 - Transferred to HQRE 2 Div, but remained at Hamelin

Sep 1964 - 35 Regt moves to Hamelin

  

Nov 1972-Mar 1973 - In N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role

Mar-Jun 1974 - In N. IRELAND

Feb-Jun 1976 - In N. IRELAND

Dec 1977 - 35 Engr Regt redesignated 4 Armd Div Engrs and Sqn still  
In Regt

Jun-Nov 1980 - In N. IRELAND

Jan 1981 - 4 Armd Div Engr Regt re-titled 35 Engr Regt
