Jul 1905	-	Redesignated a <u>Fortress Coy (Electrical)</u>
1914-1918	-	A draft finding unit
Jan 1922	-	DEVONPORT at Cadre strength only
May 1933	-	<u>Absorbed</u> by 4 (Fortress) Coy
Oct 1936	-	Re-formed and redesignated a <u>Fortress Coy</u> in SINGAPORE with an AA Searchlight role
Feb 1942	-	<u>Over-run by the Japanese</u>
May 1950	-	Formed as an <u>Engr Sqn</u> in 35 Army Engr Regt in EGYPT
1950	-	Re-titled a <u>Fd Sqn</u>

- Jan 1953 - Moved to CYPRUS but remained under comd 35 Regt
- Jan 1954 - Remainder of 35 Regt joins the Sqn in Cyprus
- Dec 1955 - To RIPON with the Regt
- Aug 1956 - To MARCHWOOD, with the Regt to prepare for Suez operations in
a port operating role
- Nov 1956 - To PORT SAID and then CYPRUS with the Regt
- Jan 1957 - Returned to RIPON with the Regt and reverts to normal role
- Becomes an air portable unit in sp of 24 Indep Inf Bde, but still
under comd of Regt of Regt
- Nov 1957 - To OSNABRUCK with the Regt
- Sep 1964 - To HAMELIN with the Regt
- Sep 1966-Apr 1967 - ADEN
- Apr 1969 - Transfers to under comd 32 Engr Regt which was at Hohne, but
remained at Hamelin and under local comd of 35 Regt
- Nov 1970 - Moved to HOHNE to join 32 Regt
- Nov 1971-Mar 1972 - In N. IRELAND
- Jan-May 1974 - In N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role
- Mar-Jun 1976 - In N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role
- Sep 1977 - Transfers to 26 Engr Regt and moves to ISERLOHN
- Jan 1978 - 26 Fengr Regt re-titled 3 Armd Div Engr Regt with Sqn still
under comd
- Jul-Nov 1978 - To N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role
- Jan 1981 - 3 Armd Div Engr Regt re-titled 26 Engr Regt
