- Nov 1948 - Formed as an Assault Pk Sqn in 32 Assault Engr Regt, at
PERHAM DOWN, by re-titling 631 Assault Engr Pk Sqn
- Feb 1954 - Disbanded
- Mar 1961 - Formed as a Stores Sqn under 1 ESD and Wksp, at LONG MARSTON
by re-titling X Sqn
- Jan 1965 - Disbanded as a Sqn and re-titled X Stores Area
- Jan 1968 - Formed as 31 Wksp Sqn in 41 Engr Pk Regt at LONG MARSTON
- Dec 1970 - Disbanded (note that 31 Armd Engr Sqn formed prior to this
disbandment)
- Sep 1969 - Formed as an Armoured Engr Sqn under local comd only of
32 Engr Regt, at HOHNE, by taking two Tps from 26 Armd
Engr Sqn and one Tp from 2 Armd Engr Sqn
- Mar 1971 - Moved to OSNABRUCK and ceased to be under local comd of
32 Engr Regt and came under comd HQRE 2 Div
- Jul-Nov 1973 - In N. IRELAND
- Dec 1974-Apr 1975 - In N. IRELAND, under temporary comd 21 Engr Regt in the
Inf role
- Jan 1978 - Moved to MUNSTERLAGER
- Apr 1978 - Amalgamated with 26 Armd Engr Sqn to form 26 Corps Armd
Engr Sqn
- Jan 1980 - Formed as an Armd Engr Sqn, at MUNSTERLAGER, in 32 Armd
Engr Regt
- 16 Jul-22 Aug 1993 - Ex Med Man 4 (BATUS)
- 24 Sep-1 Nov 1994 - Ex Med Man 6 (BATUS) SHQ + 6 Tp
