DIARY OF EVENTS

(Record of changes of location, designation and operational moves)

- Jul 1858 - Formed as a Service Coy at CHATHAM
- May 1859 - PORTSMOUTH
- Mar 1861 - CHATHAM
- Apr 1861 - Redesignated a Depot Coy
- Apr 1885 - Re-titled 'C' Depot Coy
- Nov 1887 - Formed as a Fortress Coy at CHATHAM
- Aug 1888 - CORK
- Mar 1890 - BERMUDA
- Oct 1905 - Half the Coy to CHATHAM while other half remains in Bermuda
and is absorbed there by 27 Coy
- May 1906 - SIERRA LEONE
- 1914-1916 - Half Coy in CAMEROONS expedition
- Sep 1929 - Disbanded
- Oct 1938 - Formed as a Fortress Coy for Defence Electric Light
- 1938 - SINGAPORE
- 1942 - Over-run by Japanese
- Jul 1947 - Company formed in Nigeria on Cadre basis only
- Feb 1949 - Expanded to full strength
- 1951 - A Field Sqn, in Nigeria, at KANDUNA, re-titled 36 (Nigeria)
Indep Fd Sqn, West African Engineers
- 1956 - Sqn 'Africanised' and became 36 Indep Fd Sqn of the Nigerian
Military Engineers under Nigerian Govt. In 1962 became
1 Fd Sqn Nigerian Army Engineers
- Dec 1962 - Formed as 36 RSME Sqn in Depot Regt, at CHATHAM, by
re-titling 59 RSME Sqn
