- Aug 1862 - Formed as 39 Depot Coy at CHATHAM, to supply NCOs for India
- Apr 1885 - Re-titled 'F' Depot Coy
- May 1888 - Formed as a Submarine Mining Coy at CHATHAM
- Mar 1890 - SHEERNESS
- Jul 1890 - CHATHAM
- Nov 1890 - SHEERNESS
- Apr 1901 - Became Brennan School Coy
- Jul 1905 - Redesignated 39 Fortress Coy (Electric Light)
- Sep 1913-1914 - Detachment at GRAVESEND
- 1918 - Redesignated a Wks Coy
- Aug 1918 - FRANCE
- 1919 - Reduced to a Cadre and returned to SHEERNESS
- Jun 1919 - Amalgamated with 598 (T and M) Fortress Coy to form
39 (Fortress) Coy at Sheerness
- May 1934 - Absorbed by 4 (Fortress) Coy
- Apr 1938 - Formed as a Fortress Coy at FREETOWN, Sierra Leone for
defence electric lights
- Jun 1943 - Disbanded
- Feb 1949 - Formed as a Fd Sqn, at RIPON, in 24 Fd Engr Regt
- Oct 1949 - Transferred to 32 Assault Engr Regt at PERHAM DOWN
- Jan 1950 - Re-titled 55 Fd Sqn
- Jan 1951 - Formed as a Fd Sqn in 25 Fd Engr Regt at MAIDSTONE
- Nov 1951 - To CYPRUS with the Regt
- Apr 1952 - To EGYPT with the Regt
- Jan 1955 - Returns to MAIDSTONE with the Regt
- Aug 1957 - To CHRISTMAS ISLAND with the Regt
- Feb 1958 - Returns to MAIDSTONE with the Regt
- Sep 1958 - To OSNABRUCK with the Regt
- Apr-Oct 1967 - ADEN on an emergency tour
- Mar-Jul 1972 - In N. IRELAND

- Jul-Dec 1973 - In N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role
- Jun-Oct 1975 - In N. IRELAND
- Sep 1976 - 25 and 23 Regts amalgamate to form 2 Armd Div Engr Regt
At Osnabruck, with the Sqn as part of the Regt
- Jun-Oct 1977 - In N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role
- Oct 1979-Jan 1980 - In N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role
- Jan 1981 - 2 Armd Div Engr Regt redesignated 25 Engr Regt with Sqn
still under comd and at Osnabruck
- Jan 1983 - Sqn transferred to 23 Engr Regt on its formation at Osnabruck
