DIARY OF EVENTS

(Record of changes of location, designation and operational moves)

- Apr 1868 - Formed as 41 Depot Coy (Bengal) at CHATHAM prior to moving to ROORKEE
- Apr 1885 - Redesignated 'H' Depot Coy
- Mar 1889 - 41 Fortress Coy formed at CHATHAM
- Jan 1891 - Half Coy to CEYLON and half Coy to SINGAPORE

- May 1906 - Half Coy in Ceylon absorbed by 31 Coy
- 1942 - Coy overrun by Japanese
- Jan 1947 - 41 Fortress Coy formed at SINGAPORE with Malayan troops but British SNCOs and officers
- Jan 1948 - Coy disbanded by absorption into Base Gp RE at SINGAPORE
- Jan 1950 - 41 Engr Pk Sqn formed at CRICKHOWELL, in 37 Army Engr Regt by re-titling of 74 Engr Pk Sqn
- Re-titled 41 Fd Pk Sqn
- Nov 1950 - Moved to OSNABRUCK with the Regt
- 1954 - Sqn leaves the Regt, but remains under it for local comd
- Oct 1955 - Transferred to 36 Corps Engr Regt, still in OSNABRUCK
- 1957 - Joined 40 Adv Engr Stores Regt at HAMELIN as 41 Army Fd Pk Sqn
- 1958 - Disbanded
- Nov 1958 - 339 Plant Pk Sqn re-titled 41 Plant Pk Sqn, at WILLICH, under 40 Adv Engr Stores Regt

- 1970 - Re-titled 41 Army Sp Sqn
- Oct 1977 - 40 Adv Engr Stores Regt disbanded
- Jan 1978 - Sqn disbanded
