bicycle transport

- May 1947 - Redesignated a Fd Sqn
- Aug 1947 - ISERLOHN with 2 Div
- Jul 1948 - Joined 23 Fd Engr Regt, at Iserlohn
- Jan 1949 - To HAMELIN with the Regiment
- Jul 1950 - To DORTMUND with the Regiment
- May 1958 - 23 Regt disbanded and Sqn came under command HQRE 4 Div in
support of 5 Inf Bde and moved to ISERLOHN
- Mar 1960 - To PADERBORN, still in Sp of 5 Inf Bde and under HQRE 4 Div
- Jan 1964 - Transferred Sp to 20 Armd Bde, still at Paderborn and in 4 Div

- Apr 1969 - Joined 26 Engr Regt when it was formed from 4 Div Engrs
- Nov 1970 - To ISERLOHN with the Regiment
- Apr-Jul 1971 - In N. IRELAND, temporarily under command of 21 Engr Regt, in
the Infantry role
- Mar-Jul 1973 - In N. IRELAND
- Jul-Nov 1974 - In N. IRELAND with the Regiment in the Infantry role
- Jan 1978 - 26 Regt re-formed as 3 Armd Div Engr Regt, still at Iserlohn,
With Sqn under comd
- Jul-Nov 1978 - In N. IRELAND with the Regt in the Inf role
- Jan 1981 - 3 Armd Div Engr Regt re-titled 26 Engr Regt, still at Iserlohn,
with the Sqn still under comd

- May 1993 - Under Comd 22 Engr Regt – moved to TIDWORTH
